CTE funds can be used to purchase these.</li> <li>Ms. Horton will collaborate with Ms. Edwards to arrange a First Steps experience with Nursing Fundamentals students next year.</li> <li>We need to meet with the RCS counselors early in the 2016-17 School year.</li> <li>We need to steer 2016-17 11th grade class into Anatomy &amp; Physiology class if available; and need to work on securing AP Chemistry classes within our high schools to be in place by the time that they become seniors.</li> <li>We need to create a cohort of rising 9th grade students who might be interested in a career in nursing based on interest inventories.
